## Curriculum at G World School

G World is the only school in the Tri-city that incorporates life skills and value education as their core academic areas. Education at G World is an amalgamation of modern education techniques and methods that help our children gain a 360 degree success in terms of learning, application, and creation.

The curriculum at G World is designed to bring out the best in every child and we strive for that in every learning area.

### Key areas of G World Curriculum

1. **Customised Adaptive Learning (CAL):** This is a key feature of our curriculum where we believe in developing accountability on the child's part to learn and become capable of higher learning in life. CAL is about goal setting, exploring the ways to achieve that goal, and working towards achieving that goal by following specific strategies.
2. **Language Skill Development Program:** A unique online solution that helps children learn the skills of the English language through a specially designed program that caters to the milestones of learning the language skills as per age and grade level.
3. **Super Curriculum:** This special addition to academics makes the application of the learning more significant. We offer four verticals under this curriculum:
  - SEWA
  - Design Thinking
  - Entrepreneurship
  - Green Practices

**SEWA** stands for Service, Empathy, Wisdom, and Action. Students at G World are exposed to different situations where they have to make use of these faculties of their personality. They must serve, empathise, use their wisdom to form an informed decision and finally take action to achieve the outcome.

**Design Thinking** is an innovative approach to apply the learning. Students are designated different projects where they have to follow the steps of the Design Thinking Process to prepare a prototype and finally convert that into the product.

**Entrepreneurship:** The best way to make students resilient is to put them through a process of problem solving which encompasses identification, brainstorming, applying, failing, and rethinking. Entrepreneurs are the biggest risk takers which help them become the most efficient and resilient individuals too!

**Green practices:** Sustainability is at the heart of G World pedagogy and ideology. We strongly believe that a clean and green environment helps us grow well and help us stay healthy. At G World, single use plastic and environment polluting substances are completely prohibited. The birthday policy prohibits candy and chocolate distribution and cold drinks are not allowed helping children appreciate the healthy food choices.

- 1. Differentiated Teaching and Learning:** At G world, learning resources for children are differentiated in terms of '**content**', '**process**', '**environment**', and '**product**'. Differentiated practices are conducted to enable children to work on their concern areas with respect to academics and the other domains of learning. Students are identified in every grade level who require assistance and a differentiated approach is adopted to enable the child to upskill.
- 2. Enriched Almanac:** Our school Almanac is one of its kind which hosts a detailed reward policy for children covering the different domains of growth. A well- researched habit tracker which encourages children to formulate healthy habits for themselves by fixing the accountability of habit development on the individuals.
